TODAY'S TECH TERMS

- Bot/Botnet** -- A virus-like file that, if installed to your computer, can give someone remote access to your computer.
- Cache** -- Your web browser's "temporary storage" of website files for quicker display of regularly visited websites.
- Cookies** -- Notes on websites you've visited so upon re-visits, the website can offer a more personalized display.
- Domain Name** -- The "dot com" (or .org, .net, etc.) name for a website that acts as its Internet address.
- Emoticon** --Emotions made using punctuation or graphics in email, texts, and comments :-) :^D :-(:-(
- Emoji** -- A small image or icon used to express an idea, emotion, etc., in emails, texts, etc. 🙌 😂 🎉
- Gigabyte** -- Quantity measurement for data -- 1 Gigabyte = 1,000 Megabytes.
- Hashtag** -- A name created with # (#lvtcc) to help track comments made on a specific post/article.
- Internet of Things** -- A term to describe how so many devices now use and connect to the Internet.
- Phishing** -- Faking a name or address in email or web to get personal/financial information from a victim.
- Spyware** -- Virus-like programs that can track what you do (what you type) and where you go online.
- USB** -- "Universal Serial Bus" A standard connecting charging cords and peripheral devices (printers) to a computer.
- Wi-Fi** -- "Wireless Fidelity" The wireless communication from devices to a router for Internet at a home or business.

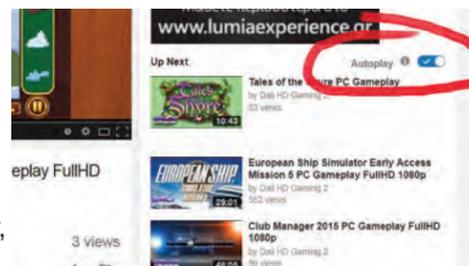

YOUTUBE VIDEO WEBSITE TIPS

YouTube (www.youtube.com) is a handy website for watching movie trailers, video clips, music videos, finding "how to" videos and even finding tutorials for your computer, tablet or phone! Here are some helpful tips for making YouTube easier and better to use:

1. Use keyboard shortcuts: Press the spacebar to stop and start videos, use "Home" to go back to the beginning and "End" to get to the end. Press "M" to mute. By using the keyboard, you don't have to move the mouse to get the cursor back and then find/do all the controls.



2. Deactivate "Autoplay": If you don't want the next video to play automatically, look for the "Autoplay" slider in the upper right corner. If it's "on" (blue, with a check mark) click the check mark to turn autoplay "off".

3. Expand your view: To make the viewing screen larger, find and click the icons in the lower right corner of the viewing window. Choose from "theater" mode or "full screen" mode. (press escape key to get out of full-screen mode)



4. Use the Settings icon (the gear) to view and change Autoplay, Annotations (notes), and Quality right from the video screen. If the video is choppy, try lowering the quality it is trying to use.



5. Remove suggested videos and categories from your main screen. If you don't like the suggested videos YouTube shows on your main YouTube page, you can put your mouse on the "three dots" in the upper right corner of the preview screen and then click "Not Interested" to remove that video OR click the "x" in the upper right corner of the category to remove the entire category.



6. Click the blue "Sign in" button to sign in with your Gmail account to customize your YouTube main screen and have the ability to upload your own videos to YouTube to start your own YouTube channel!

Additional Tips For YouTube On A Mobile Device:

7. Download the YouTube app instead of using your mobile browser. YouTube will play much better through the app than through the browser because it will be optimized for mobile use (screen size, resolution, etc.)

8. Make sure to use YouTube from a Wi-Fi connection, and NOT the Cellular network (unless you have Unlimited data). Watching video uses a lot of data.

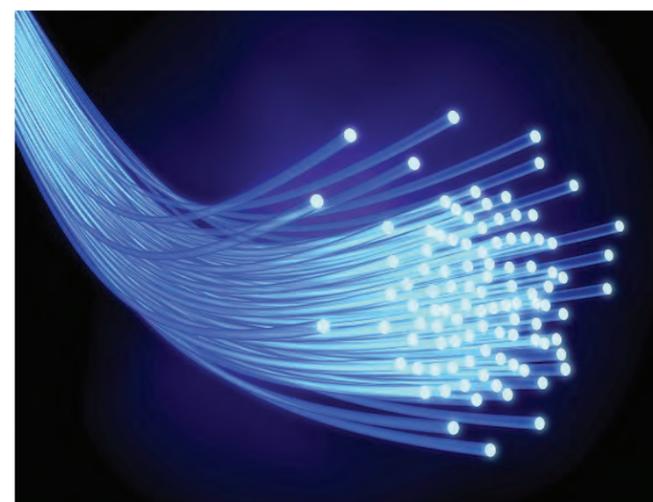


TCC IS "GIG" CERTIFIED

What does it mean to be "GIG" Certified? It means our network has been tested and deemed capable of providing reliable and consistent Internet speeds of up to 1 Gigabit per second (1,000 Megabits per second). This is a very special designation as not all Internet providers are certified to 1 Gbps. Many cannot get close, and a few may claim they can but have not been tested and certified as being capable.

How did we get designated as GIG Certified? We applied with the NTCA, the Rural Broadband Association, to do an onsite test of our network. Upon testing our network and being satisfied we can deliver 1 Gigabit per second speeds, we were officially certified as a GIG Provider.

What does it mean for us? For you? - For TCC, it backs up our claim of having a super-fast, reliable network from an independent, broadband-focused organization. For you, it means you can have confidence that we are capable of delivering the speeds we say we can deliver -- up to 1 Gigabit per second. While residential users may not have a need for such fast speeds at this time, businesses and schools often do have a need for such speeds -- which makes our area a great place to be and TCC a great company to establish Internet services through.



Our GIG Certification, along with our "Smart Rural Community" certification (featured in our August 2017 Newsletter) are two designations TCC has earned due to our constant efforts to provide top-notch services over a fast and reliable network and to go above and beyond just providing basic services to our members and actually taking an active role to advance the technology culture in our communities.
