






Gross Plant




Operating Revenues



Net Plant




Net Margins





COOPERATIVE REPORT FROM CEO, CHERYL RUE

What a year it has been! This past year, we have navigated our way through the unprecedented times due to the uncertainty created by the COVID-19 pandemic. We worked diligently to ensure the continued safety of our employees and members, establishing precautionary measures and restricted public access to our offices. For a short period of time, early in the pandemic, we discontinued installs and closed our lobbies. Once things settled a bit, we worked diligently to get back to the level of service installations we had in the past and to opening our lobbies. At the January Board Meeting, the Board of Directors determined, with recommendations from the Trempealeau County Health Department, it was in the best interest of the members and staff of the cooperative to hold the annual membership meeting virtually.

On Tuesday, March 30, 2021, the 57th Annual Membership Meeting was held virtually. It was also recorded and will be available on our website and on WTCO (formerly TCCTV) over the next several weeks. With all of that said, on behalf of the Board of Directors and employees, it is an honor and privilege to serve our membership.

Last year was a great year for TCC! Our membership grew by 551 ending the year with 8,386 members strong, with 7,485 members subscribing to our broadband.

While we often talk about our advanced technology, infrastructure, and the need to keep pace with the demands for high-speed broadband services and applications, TCC also continues to give back to the communities we serve as well. This includes several thousands of dollars donated to backpack and Curds for Kids food programs for area schools, scholarships, sponsorship donations, employee volunteers, and special events. In the pages that follow, we have provided you with the financial statements that portray the stability and economic strength of TCC.

This year, TCC offered twenty-five \$500 general scholarships and two \$1,000 scholarships to current high-school seniors furthering their education in a telecommunications/IT related field of study. The 56th Annual Member Meeting of Tri-County Communications Cooperative, Inc. was held on Tuesday, April 28, 2020. Due to concerns for the health and safety of cooperative members and staff in connection with the global coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, and in adherence with government restrictions against public gatherings, the annual member meeting was held virtually via a Facebook live video broadcast. President Russell Carlisle called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. and welcomed those in attendance. He declared a quorum had been reached for purposes of director elections, and requested the members ratify all other meeting actions at the next member meeting.

Attorney Von Ruden reported that a quorum of the members had been established for purposes of the director elections. He then reported that Lynn Nelson was elected director for the Northfield/Pigeon Falls/Pleasantville/Whitehall District.
