TCC Streaming TV Feature

“Cloud DVR”

When you have the new TCC Streaming TV service, you get a built-in feature called **Cloud DVR**. A DVR is for recording programs and watching them at your convenience, like a VCR, only easier. A DVR also records as you watch so you can pause live TV and resume when you are ready.

A cloud DVR means all of your content is stored on our server, not on your personal device, such as your Amazon Fire Stick. You can record and watch stored content from any of your streaming devices and you don't lose your stored content if your streaming device fails or is removed.

TCC Streaming TV includes **250 Gigabytes** of storage (**75 to 150 hours*** of programming, depending on program quality). For \$5 more per month, you can upgrade to 500 Gigabytes of storage!

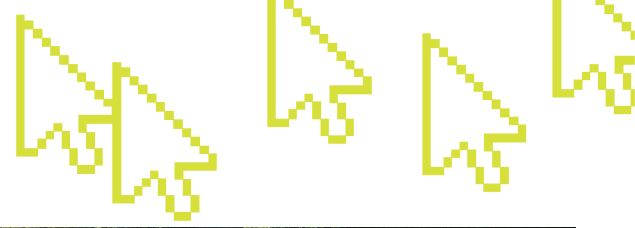

TCC is expanding its fiber optics!

TCC is continuing to expand its fiber network for better speed and reliability for Internet, TV and telephone service. We have contractors putting fiber in the Village of Fairchild and towns of Alma, Clear Creek and Pleasant Valley.

In the Village of Fairchild, it is largely an “overbuild” replacing our existing coaxial cable with fiber optics for improved service. In the the towns of Alma, Clear Creek and Pleasant Valley, this is brand new fiber to provide residents with access to high-speed Internet, TV and telephone service.
